**Recycling properly is essential to lowering fees for residents and the township; as well as ensuring recycling is actually recycled, and not rejected and sent to a landfill or incinerator due to contamination of food or non-recyclable materials.**

Please familiarize yourself with what is accepted in single stream recycling. Make sure items are clean and dry, and loose in a can. Recycling stickers for cans are available at the township building at no cost.

- Squeeze pouches and caps
- Personal care items
- Chip/snack bags
- Brita filters
- Corks
- Cell phones
- Shoes
- Bar wrappers
- Eyeglasses
- Plastic Bags
- Batteries
- Compost

Newspapers

#### Cardboard

Ream wrappers  
File folders  
Poster Board  
Frozen food boxes  
Cardboard boxes  
Milk cartons



#### Plastics - clean & hard only

Water bottles  
Take-out containers  
Soda bottles



#### Aluminum & Metal

Aluminum beverage cans  
Food cans  
Scrap metal



#### Glass\*

Beverage containers  
Glass food jars  
\*Glass recycling varies by location



### DO NOT...

Place any of these items in a recycling bin or cart:

#### Plastic Bags

Plastic bags are a SERIOUS contaminant and jam soiling machines at recycling facilities

#### Plastic Bags with recyclables inside

#### Shredded paper/small items



#### Scrap Metal

#### Hazardous household materials

Paint, automotive fluids or cleaners must be desposed

#### No flattened bottles/cans

#### Non-recyclable plastics

Such as lose lids, Styrofoam or any miscellaneous plastic without a recycling logo:  

#### Caps/Lids on glass jars and bottles

#### Liquids or food

#### Unwashed containers still contaminated with food

#### Non-recyclable glass

#### Rope-like items

Such as water hoses, holiday lights, belts

#### Diapers, Bio-Hazardous Waste

#### Electronics, toys, light bulbs, and batteries

**When in doubt  throw it out**  
(in the garbage)

**Please bring plastic bags & film packaging to your grocery store for recycling!**
